

SCREENING FACILITY INFORMATION

The Cajundome Screening Facility will open at 9 a.m. tomorrow morning and go until 3:00 p.m. Please see the criteria below for who should go. People will need to bring an I.D., Insurance Card, and if they have no insurance they will need to have a \$50 dollar payment ready. If folks have questions about whether or not they should go, beginning either later this afternoon or early tomorrow morning they can dial 311 and press 1 to speak with a medical professional who can assess them and tell them whether or not to get screened.

1. Patients with symptoms of acute viral respiratory illness (coughing or Shortness of breath) AND/OR temp > 100.4
2. Patients that have symptoms and are pregnant or considered **high-risk*** will first be tested for flu.
3. If flu negative, specimen is sent for COVID-19 testing.

Who is high risk?

- **Healthcare workers with direct contact** with confirmed/suspected COVID case
- **Pregnant women**
- Patients with **immunocompromised conditions** (such as receiving immunosuppressive medications, solid organ transplant, hemodialysis, chronic lung disease, active cancer, HIV, diabetes)
- 60 years of age or older
- **People living in communal settings** (nursing facilities, shelters, etc.)
- **Infants \leq 10 weeks of age/adjusted gestational age.**
