# JOB DESCRIPTIONS PWPCT SOUTH LOUISIANA Final Adopted at Spring Gathering in 2013

# GENERAL EXPECTATIONS OF PWPCT MEMBERS:

Attend Coordinating Team meetings and all gathering events;

Support the Purpose of Presbyterian Women;

Arrive at all gatherings and meetings early enough to be able to be available to help set up the programs and arrangements for the day;

Stay at gatherings until gathering place is restored to its proper condition;.

Be willing, with some financial help, to attend training events for your job;

File written reports for the PWPCT meetings with the moderator, when requested;

Make a brief oral report at the meeting; and

Be timely in reporting when you cannot attend a meeting (emergencies excepted).

# MODERATOR:

Preside at all meetings and gatherings;

Represent PWPCT at Churchwide and Synod Gatherings;

Attend presbytery meetings as voting representative;

Be ex-officio member of PWPCT committees, except Search;.

Represent PW on the proper committee of Presbytery, or appoint another member to do so; Coordinate PWPCT work and dates:

Know about all PWPCT members' job descriptions and responsibilities;

Make all appointments, per bylaws;

Receive, distribute and collect Mission Pledge Forms from moderators of local

congregations as determined by Churchwide CT;

Lead local PWCCT in planning and evaluating all programs;

Be available as often as possible to represent PW in events occurring in the presbytery and synod, as well as local churches;

Keep up-to-date on Churchwide planning and issues:

Interpret PW in all aspects of church work within the presbytery:

Serve on finance committee; and

Give written reports, when required.

### VICE MODERATOR (OR CO-MODERATOR):

Preside when the moderator is not available;

As co-moderator, preside as decided with the moderator;

Assist the moderator as well as other PWPCT members, as needed;

Serve as Search Committee Chair;

Be responsible for evaluation sheets at PWPCT planned meetings and gathered event;

Coordinate leadership training (plan and/or promote);

Chair the revisions committee, when changes to the bylaws are necessary;

Serve on finance committee; and

Serve as Cluster Leader Coordinator.

### SECRETARY:

Prepare and preserve minutes of all PWP Coordinating Team meetings;

Send these minutes to the moderator so they can be distributed with reports to all PWPCT members prior to PWPCT meetings; and

Compile and have printed the annual directories listing the moderators or contact persons of each local group, PWCCT for congregations, PWPCT for presbyteries, PWSCT for synod, CCTPW churchwide and other pertinent information. These shall be distributed after the Spring Gathering of each calendar year to cluster leaders, who will get one to each local moderator or contact person.

Assist with correspondence, as requested:

Distribute information each year on Mission Pledges, providing contact information of treasurer for collection and inclusion in annual budget; and

Keep records of the Spring Gathering or other such large PW gatherings and the PWPCT.

#### HISTORIAN:

Keep a record of events and leaders of the organization in a manner that they will be available in the future:

Assist the historical research as needed;

Call for and gather histories of local church PW, to be sent to the PW Synod Historian; Assist local churches with displays or other presentations of materials, as requested; and Forward local histories, minutes or PWPCT and financial records of PW of South Louisiana to Presbyterian Historical Society.

## TREASURER:

Pay the bills and forward monies promptly;

Collect local PW pledges and disburse them on time;

Encourage local PWs to make timely payments on their financial commitments;

Send quarterly/annual report form for each PWCCT;

Prepare annual reports that will be presented at the PWPCT meeting after January 1<sup>st</sup>, but before the annual meeting, where it will be presented;

Inform PWPCT members of budget request deadlines:

Serve on Finance Committee:

Prepare budget for adoption at January PWPCT;

Assist the moderator with collection of mission pledges;

Send a copy of the monthly bank statements to the moderator and secretary;

Help local treasurers become interpreters of PW mission and giving pattern;

Be the presbytery representative for publications and encourage their use; and

Order resources, and encourage creative use of these materials.

#### **BIBLE MODERATOR**

Attend training for PW Bible study each year;

Present overview of PW Bible study at fall rallies each year;

Serve as Bible study resource for Clusters and Congregations, as requested;

Participate in PWPCT of South Louisiana activities; and

Report to PWPCT of South Louisiana on activities related to Bible study.

## **CLUSTER LEADERS:**

Be the liaison between the local churches assigned to her and the PWPCT:

Assist the moderator with making contact with local churches by mail, email or phone calls;

Identify leadership in PWC groups and provide to moderator and secretary;

Offer to do leadership training and goal setting at local churches, assisted by other

PWPCT members (example: mission chairs should assist with mission training);

Offer to install local church leaders or to speak at their groups;

Offer to interpret Birthday Offering, Least Coin and Thank Offering to local PW group;

Be available to attend local church events when invited to represent PW;

Convey needs and concerns of local churches to the PWPCT in a timely manner;

Attend leadership training events;

Give a written report and a brief oral report at each PWPCT in a timely manner;

Attend leadership training events;

Give a written report and brief oral report at each PWPCT meeting; and

Serve on the search committee.

## SEARCH COMMITTEE CHAIR (VICE MODERATOR):

The search committee will consist of the vice moderator as chair and cluster leaders as committee members:

The search committee will seek leaders for PWPCT;

Nominate one person for each PWPCT position, as needed;

Have a slate ready by a month before the annual Spring Gathering;

Use job descriptions and bylaws as sources of information to be given to potential nominees;

Assist moderator with appointment;

Prepare and maintain a list of potential committee members with information on talents,

interests, geographic areas, church size and racial ethnic background;

Offer names from these lists to persons requesting assistance; and

Review and revise all job descriptions annually.

# **MISSION COORDINATOR:**

Interpret missions of PW to PWPCT to local churches;

Be knowledgeable in goals and programs of Together in Service;

Prepare displays for PW and presbytery gatherings to keep our mission alive;

Keep abreast of financial needs in areas of mission, social concern, or local emergency situations in order to assist local churches who are looking for ways to help:

Give an annual written report to be shared at the Spring Gathering; and

Give a written report and a brief oral report at PWPCT meeting.

## JUSTICE AND PEACE COORDINATOR:

Facilitate the PWPCT with information concerning justice and peace issues involving church;

Interpret justice and peace issues as needed to the local churches; and

Write articles of interest concerning justice and peace issues for both presbytery and PWP newsletter.

### **ECUMENICAL RELATIONS REPRESENTATIVE:**

Facilitate PW of the congregations with needs and programs of ecumenical relationships:

Provide materials of PW events; and

Attend ecumenical meetings in your area as a representative of PWP.

# TECHNICAL ADVISOR:

Advise PWPCT on new ways to use the computer in electronic communication;.

Keep a database of Presbyterian women who attend PW events;

Assemble records or lists of local leaders, their addresses, phone numbers and email addresses;

Teach interested local leaders how to utilize the computer for PW work; and Provide a list of helpful websites to be used by PWP.

# BYLAWS, PRESBYTERIAN WOMEN IN THE PRESBYTERY OF SOUTH LOUISIANA

#### ARTICLE 1 - TITLE

The name of the organization shall be Presbyterian Women (PW) in the Presbytery of South Louisiana.

## **ARTICLE II - PURPOSE**

Forgiven and freed by God in Jesus

Christ, and empowered by the Holy Spirit, we commit ourselves;

To nurture our faith through prayer and Bible study,

To support the mission of the church worldwide,

To work for justice and peace, and

To build an inclusive, caring community of women that strengthens the Presbyterian Church (USA) and witnesses to the promise of God's Kingdom

### **ARTICLE III - MEMBERSHIP**

Members of PW in the presbytery shall be men and women within the presbytery who choose to participate in, or be supportive of PW in the Presbyterian Church in any way.

## ARTICLE IV- COORDINATING TEAM, ELECTION AND TERM OF OFFICE

Section 1. The leaders shall form a Coordinating Team (PWPCT) for conducting the business of PW in the presbytery. It shall convene at least three times per year.

Section 2. The Search Committee shall present names of women and men who have agreed to serve on the Coordinating Team to the members of the PW in the presbytery (PWP) at an annual Spring Gathering. Leaders of PW in the presbytery shall be members of the PC (USA).

Section 3. The term of office for all leaders, except PW Cluster Leaders, shall be two years (with the privilege of serving a second term only).

Section 4. The leaders of PW in the presbytery shall be (co-moderators or moderator and vice-moderator, Secretary, Historian, Treasurer, Four (4) Cluster Leaders and Members-at-Large, Justice and Peace Coordinator, Mission Opportunities Coordinator, Technical Advisor, Bible Moderator and Ecumenical Relations Representative. Additional leaders may be Membership-at-large with specific responsibilities to carry out the work of PW, as needed.

Moderators and Co-Moderators (odd years)
Vice-Moderator (odd years)
Secretary (odd years)
Historian (even years)
Treasurer (even years)

Appointed Members of the PWPCT
Mission Coordinator (even years)
Justice and Peace Coordinator (odd years)
Bible Moderator (even years)
Ecumenical Relations (even years)
Technical Advisor (odd years)
4 Cluster/Area Leaders
Additional Members shall be Members-At-Large

Section 5. Cluster Leaders shall have three year terms from the date of adoption of the bylaws (2013), divided into groups according to their area. The term for Group 1 will end in 2016 and includes Areas 1 and 3. The term for Group 2 will end in 2015 and includes Areas 2 and 4 (the geographic description of each Area is included in the Appendix).

### ARTICLE V - DUTIES OF THE COORINATING TEAM

The Coordinating Team shall:

Plan for regular gatherings, cluster meetings and special interest gatherings. Identify issues of concern for PW.

Provide program support and resources through the Cluster Leaders and related staff to PW in the congregations.

Provide for representative(s) to serve on Presbytery Council and/or presbytery committees, ecumenical committees and projects, as appropriate.

All meetings of the Coordinating Team shall be open to any member of PW in the presbytery; the member has privileges of observation only, without a voice or vote.

#### **ARTICLE VI - FINANCES**

The program of PW in the presbytery will be financed through pledges of PW in the congregation and the operating expenses of the presbytery. The treasures of PW in the congregations shall send the recommended amount to the Treasurer of PW in the presbytery. The financial records shall be reviewed annually by a public accountant or a committee of members versed in accounting procedures, none of whom shall be related to the Treasurer(s).

#### **ARTICLE VII - GATHERINGS**

PW in the presbytery shall meet at least annually and more often, if appropriate. These gatherings shall be open to all women and men. The installation of leaders and approval of the budget shall be done in the context of the Spring Gathering of PW in the presbytery.

### **ARTICLE VIII - REPRESENTATION**

PW shall give full expression to the rich diversity within its membership in order to assure a greater inclusiveness leading to wholeness. In implementing this commitment, consideration should be given to the diversity of gifts and talents that exist within PW. Persons of all racial ethnic groups and different ages shall be guaranteed full participation and access to presentation in the decision making of PW.

#### **ARTICLE IX – AMENDMENTS**

These bylaws may be amended at any annual gathering of two-thirds vote of those present and voting, provided notice of the proposed amendments have been submitted in writing to the PW in the Congregations at least thirty (30) days prior to the gathering.

#### ARTICLE X - QUORUM

The quorum for the annual gathering of PW in the presbytery shall be 30 members of Presbyterian Women.

### ARTICLE XI - PARIAMENTARY AUTHORITY

The rules contained in Robert's Rules of Order Newly Revised shall govern PW in the Presbyterian Church (USA) in all cases in which they are applicable and to which they are not inconsistent with these bylaws and the Constitution of the PC (USA).

# Birthday Offering \*

The Birthday Offering is a special offering collected in the spring of each year to celebrate the blessings in the lives of Presbyterian Women. No giving guidelines are suggested other than "give as you are blessed." The offering funds up to five specific projects that are not included in ongoing General Assembly mission support.

# **Birthday Offering Grants**

Birthday Offering grants range from \$50,000 to \$250,000. Grant applications come from a variety of sources, such as PC(USA) governing bodies, health agencies, overseas churches, ecumenical councils, community groups, educational institutions and church related groups. Filing deadline is May 15. Get the criteria for grant eligibility and an application.

# Thank Offering \*

Collected each fall, **the Thank Offering** funds projects that meet the needs of people who are aging, disabled, homeless or displaced as well as children, youth and women through educational, health, peace and justice programs. Forty percent of this offering is used to support hospitals and community health programs. The remaining 60 percent is used for new creative ideas for mission.

### **Thank Offering Grant**

Thank Offering grants range from \$1,000 to \$30,000 and fund projects such as agricultural development, child care, community organization, criminal justice, drug counseling, economic justice, elderly care, employment training, homelessness, literacy, violence and women's concerns. The filing deadline is September 15. <u>Learn the criteria</u> for Thank Offering Grants and download an application.

# Cents-ability

# A strategy for raising awareness — and funds — for the fight against hunger

Cents-Ability is a small first step in the battle against hunger and poverty. Congregations invite every member — of all ages — to contribute a few cents at every meal. This simple act is an expression of thanks for what we have received. It is also a commitment to share with others in response to Jesus' command "You give them something to eat." When members bring their offerings to church on the appointed Sunday, all of those coins "make a joyful noise unto the Lord" as they are received and dedicated.

These small acts of faithfulness can add up: One hundred persons in a congregation will contribute \$180 a month at two cents a meal. That's \$2,160 dollars a year. A 30,000-member presbytery has the potential of raising over \$1.6 million annually at a nickel a meal.

Cents-Ability originated in 1976 as "Two-Cents-A-Meal," a project begun by Presbyterian Women to involve individuals and families in a corporate response to world hunger. Over the years, presbyteries have developed similar programs entitled Pennies for Hunger, Nickle-A-Meal, etc. Many of these programs benefit local hunger ministries as well as the national and international projects of the Presbyterian Hunger Program. (PHP).

PHP has developed a series of Cents-Ability resources to help presbyteries and congregations begin and expand hunger education and fund-raising programs. These include posters, banks, placemats, prayer table tents and a notebook full of suggestions and program models.

## CELEBRATION OF BELIEVERS THROUGH WOMEN'S PLEDGES

Why do we need to make a pledge? This is a pledge that is made to local Presbyterian Women (PW), supports the mission of the church worldwide and the basic operating budget of PW at the congregation, presbytery, synod and churchwide levels. Each year, Presbyterian women pledge over 6 million dollars to mission, which is what we care about and who we are.

The mission pledge, a gift that is over and above your pledge to your congregation, goes to help support the mission of the Presbyterian Church (USA). It is also a large portion of the operating budget at the presbytery, synod and churchwide levels.

Pledge forms are mailed to each church in late August each year, so congregational moderators should meet with their circles and discuss the pledge with the women in their church. As individual pledges are received from the women in the churches, the congregational moderator should provide the church's pledge to the PW Moderator of the Presbytery by December 1<sup>st</sup>. After all of the pledges from the churches have been collected and compiled, then the total amount pledged is added to the operating budget for PW. The pledges are then paid on a quarterly basis (March 10th, June 10th, September 10th and December 10th) to the Treasurer of PW (Susan J. Ortiz). Payments are made to *Presbyterian Women of Presbytery* and are mailed to Susan J. Ortiz, 224 Bracewell Drive, Unit D, Baton Rouge, LA. 70815.

**How do we pay the Birthday and Least Coin Offerings?** These special offerings are also mailed to Susan J. Ortiz, the Presbytery Treasurer as they are collected from the individual churches. The offerings need to be received by December 15<sup>th</sup> at the latest to be counted toward the offerings for that year.
